I asked some experts from the IPCC whether it was possible to overshoot the budgets (i.e. the yellow line in the graphs in the submission), but their reply combined with the methodology used in the submission means that overshooting the budget would not be possible and thus the green line is what we should be aiming for, though there is perhaps potential to trade future excess reductions for other countries short term extra capacity if a deal could be negotiated. Or alternatively perhaps delaying forestry harvests.
